We are pleased to share details of an externally run Dance Club available to our students this coming autumn. Please note that while this club takes place on our premises, it is organised and managed independently of the school.

Dance Club is designed to allow students to develop new dance skills and explore urban rhythms, style and flavour as well as build their creativity, self-expression and confidence. Taking part in a dance class is a great way to connect mind, body and soul in a friendly environment and unleash that inner "performer". The club will cover afro-influenced, street & commercial dance styles using a variety of music genres including afrobeat, hip hop, R&B, garage, pop and more. Classes are general level and suitable for all.

Dance Club is led by former AHS student Joey who has modelled for Adidas & Nike, worked as a professional street dancer & breaker and is an excellent teacher of dance and movement. The school's Head of Dance will also be present in the sessions.

Dance Club runs weekly on Tuesdays from 15:45 - 17:00 in the Harding Hall.
