Home Learning and Artificial Intelligence

Following our AI Information Evening last week, we wanted to write to all parents to let them know about the School's expectations surrounding the use of AI and homework. We are working hard to ensure that all students are educated surrounding the opportunities and challenges AI presents to them and our community and are also reviewing our curriculum and policies to ensure our students are still developing the foundational knowledge and skills they need in a world of this fast developing technology. For now, we ask that students ***do not use generative AI tools, such as ChatGPT, for the vast majority of homework tasks.*** Exceptions to this include:

- where a teacher sets a task and clearly states that students may make use of an AI tool should they wish
- where a teacher sets a task explicitly instructing students to use an AI tool.

We will be continually reviewing this guidance as AI technology and our school systems & policies are developed.
