Monday 29 June 2026 - Craig McLeish Singing Workshop

On Monday 29th June, Craig McLeish, the musical director of Young Voices and a very well-respected choral conductor, is visiting Turnfurlong Junior School to provide a choral workshop for the day.

I have been offered the exciting opportunity to take 20 of our Year 7s to join with other Secondary and Primary schools in the area to take part in this, and your daughter has indicated that she would like to attend. There is no cost involved for either the workshop or the performance.

Registration will take place as normal at AHS and we will then walk down to Turnfurlong, and students should all wear their normal school uniform. We will eat lunch there, so all students should bring a packed lunch with them.

At 15:30, there is a short performance planned for parents at Turnfurlong, which you are more than welcome to attend. We will then walk back to AHS, arriving back at school by 16:15.

If you are attending the performance and would like to collect your child from Turnfurlong, could you please let me know.

Consent

As you can see, spaces are severely limited and so could I ask that you talk to your daughter about whether they would like to attend and then complete this [Google Form](#). Places will be allocated randomly from the responses on **Monday 1st June** and I will contact those students that have been chosen to attend the workshop by the end of that week, placing any other students on a waiting list.

Medical Details

All medication brought on trips must be accompanied by the trip [medication form](#), which should be completed and emailed to the First Aid Administrator at least 2 weeks before the trip. This is found on the '[Trips and Visits](#)' page of the school website. **Medicines must be handed in to the trip leader in their original packaging with the information leaflet and the dispensing label attached. All medication must be within the use by date, or will not be accepted. Students will not be allowed to attend the trip if their emergency medication is not present or out of date.**

As with all trips we want students and staff to have an enjoyable experience. If either you or the school have any concerns about your daughter's ability to participate then it is vital that we discuss at an early stage how the school can appropriately support her and ensure the trip is suitable for her.
