## YEAR 7 PERFORMANCE AT YOUNG VOICES IN THE BP PULSE LIVE ARENA, BIRMINGHAM (25-ZYVCO)

Your daughter has the exciting opportunity to perform at the Young Voices concert in the BP Pulse LIVE arena in Birmingham on Friday 9 January 2026 (www.youngvoices.co.uk). This is an amazing opportunity for the students to participate in a world class concert with around 7000 pupils from schools around the United Kingdom. The concert also includes performances from Urban Strides, one of the UK's leading street dance troupes, together with singer Connie Talbot (*Britain's Got Talent*) and Broadway star, Aneesa Folds, with other performers to be announced. Your daughter will be part of the massed choir, celebrating 30 years of Young Voices and performing material they will have learnt in class during this term. A very large proportion of the year group performed last year and thoroughly enjoyed it.

I have been involved with these concerts for many years and can assure you that it will be a day that they will never forget. Students will be departing from Turnfurlong by coach at 11:00 and returning to Turnfurlong at approximately 23:00 and will be accompanied by approximately 8 adults depending on the number of students. Please make arrangements to collect your daughter from Turnfurlong at the time given. Pick-up at the Birmingham arena will not be possible due to the nature of the event, and the number of people leaving the arena at that time.

The cost of the trip is £30.

There is a very tight turnaround this year, as the date set by Young Voices for choir confirmations has been brought forward. Could you therefore please make payment on Parentmail by Monday 29 September at 9.00am so that I am able to confirm choir numbers with Young Voices. Payment for this trip will be opened on ParentMail at 19:00 on Friday 19th September. We are keen for everyone in Year 7 to have the opportunity to attend this trip but I will need to finalise numbers with Young Voices by the above date, and therefore sign-up by this date is essential. If you are unable to find the payment item on your homepage in ParentMail you can search for the item in your shop page. This payment is non-refundable unless your daughter can be replaced by another student or for cancellation due to medical reasons, confirmed by a doctor.

Once you have made this payment could you please access the following link and sign up for the Young Voices Music Room:

You should then also sign your daughter up to the Young Voices Music Room so that they are able to access the resources from home, and I will also make these available on their Google Classrooms when we start practicing them.

Once signed up, you will be able to purchase t-shirt packs and tickets for the concert. These are optional, but your child must wear a plain white t-shirt to the concert if they do not purchase a Young Voices branded pack.

If you would like to come to the concert, then tickets are available through the Music Room, and purchasing them via this route should ensure you are sitting in a position to see the school. These usually sell out early, so I would strongly advise you purchase these at the earliest possible opportunity.

Any purchased tickets and t-shirts will then be delivered to the school in advance of the concert and I will allocate these to your daughters.

We would not want anyone to be unable to take part because of financial circumstances. If you would like to apply for financial support for this trip (whether or not your daughter is eligible for Pupil Premium Funding), please complete the confidential 'Request for Financial Assistance' form accessed via the <u>Trips and Visits</u> section of the website by **Monday 22nd September**. Ticking the relevant box when making payment in ParentMail constitutes consent to this activity. Please note that the student medical information and your contact details that we hold on record will be used for the trip, so if anything has changed since you last updated us, please email the changes to your daughter's Pastoral Support Assistant.

All medication brought on trips should be accompanied by the trip <u>medication form</u>, which should be completed and emailed to Matron at least 2 weeks before the trip. This is found on the '<u>Trips and Visits</u>' page of the school website. Medicines must be handed in to the trip leader in their original packaging with the information leaflet and the dispensing label attached.

If either you or the school have any concerns about your daughter's ability to participate then it is vital that we discuss at an early stage how the school can appropriately support her and ensure the trip is suitable for her.
