YEAR 8 VISIT TO '& JULIET' AT THE MILTON KEYNES THEATRE, 03 APRIL 2025

Your daughter has the opportunity to attend a performance of '& Juliet' on Thursday 03 April 2025. The purpose of this trip is to enable students to see a live performance of music, dance and drama. Students will be departing from Turnfurlong by coach at 17.30 and returning to Turnfurlong at approximately 23.00. Please make arrangements to collect your daughter from Turnfurlong at this time. Alternatively they can be collected from the theatre if this is more convenient but please inform Mrs Hughes by email in advance of the trip. 4 members of staff will accompany the group. Students will also need to ensure that they have had something to eat beforehand as they won't be able to eat on the coach. All students will be expected to attend school the following day; by signing up for the trip, students are acknowledging that this involves a late return and expected attendance the following day.

The cost of the trip is £28.50. Please make payment on ParentMail by Monday 11 November. Payment for this trip will be opened on ParentMail at 19:00 on Thursday 17 October. There are a limited number of places on the trip and they will be allocated on a first come first serve basis. Your daughter will be added to a waiting list if all places are allocated and you will be contacted if a place becomes available. If you are unable to find the payment item on your homepage in ParentMail you can search for the item in your shop page. Refunds for students dropping out of the trip will not be possible unless they can be replaced by another student or for cancellation due to medical reasons, confirmed by a doctor.

We would not want anyone to be unable to take part because of financial circumstances. If you would like to apply for financial support for this trip (whether or not your daughter is eligible for Pupil Premium Funding), please complete the confidential 'Request for Financial Assistance' form accessed via the Parents' section of the website by Friday 1 November. Please reference the trip code: 24-ZJULI.
