**Year 8 Visit to a Chemistry at Work Day at AGS on Friday 13 March 2026 (25-CAWD)**

As part of our ongoing commitment to broadening the education of our younger students in science, we have the opportunity of taking 32 Year 8 Science students to Aylesbury Grammar School on Friday 13 March for a 'Chemistry At Work Day'.

This event is primarily funded by the Royal Society of Chemistry and is coordinated by Derek Jones, who arranges guest speakers and demonstrators. It is free of charge, there are no transport costs as students can walk to the school and it will run from 10.00 to 15:30 so there are no issues with buses. Mrs Nicholls will be accompanying the students for this day. Students will meet in the main school reception at 9.45 and will need to inform their period 1 teachers ahead of time that they will be leaving for this trip.

In the event that we have more than 32 students interested, we will draw names from a hat at random. The final list of students attending will be notified in the afternoon on Thursday 13th February.

Completing the attendance form constitutes consent to this activity. Please note that the student medical information and your contact details that we hold on record will be used for the trip, so if anything has changed since you last updated us, please email the changes to your daughter's Pastoral Support Assistant.

All medication brought on trips must be accompanied by the trip [medication form](#), which should be completed and emailed to the First Aid Administrator at least 2 weeks before the trip. **Medicines must be handed in to the trip leader in their original packaging with the information leaflet and the dispensing label attached.**

As with all trips we want students and staff to have an enjoyable experience. If either you or the school have any concerns about your daughter's ability to participate then it is vital that we discuss at an early stage how the school can appropriately support her and ensure the trip is suitable for her.
