**Year 9 Activity Day - Thursday 4 July - 24-ZADY9**

We are writing to give you details of this year's activity day for Year 9.

On **Thursday 3 July** your daughter will be taking part in an **Enterprise Day**. The students will be working on a 'Launch Pad' project led by the organisation Young Enterprise. This is a fast paced, engaging enterprise challenge which provides an introduction to employability skills. Students will work alongside inspiring Business Volunteers who support students to discover more about themselves and develop key skills which are valued in the workplace. Through a series of hands-on, fun activities students work in teams on the early stages of launching a fledgling business, balancing a budget as well as creating a brand identity and marketing strategy.

This will take place in school. Students will need to be in school uniform and lunch will be at the usual time, with the school Dining Hall opening as normal. As this day is being facilitated by Young Enterprise, along with the support of their Business volunteers we are asking for a voluntary contribution of **£11.50** per student.

We would not want anyone to be unable to take part in this activity because of financial circumstances.
